



The School Improvement Priorities for 2021-22 are:

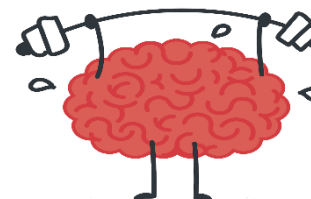
### Teaching, Learning and Assessment
